Project Overview

For this project, we were engaged as a subcontractor to revamp and reshape the berm at a terminal site in Regina, Saskatchewan.

The general on the project was looking for a team that had the experience and required training needed to work on an oil and gas terminal site. Due the safety aspects of the berm related to the tanks themselves, the project had a tight timeframe for completion, to minimize the overall risk to the actual operation.

The solution implemented involved, surveying, grading, reshaping the berm and then ensuring everything was compacted appropriately to meet the specifications for the project.

Unique Project Challenges

The biggest challenge on this project was the confines of the space on the site itself. The project required a large amount of material to be moved and piled, while at the same time being able to set up the levels for the new berm.

As with any oil and gas site, there are the tanks themselves, but more importantly there is an extensive amount of piping and other equipment that if disrupted could have a detrimental impact of the operation. Operator awareness and equipment spotting were critical components in this project.
